**Year 9 Educational Visit to The Thinktank, Birmingham  
Thursday 26 October 2023**

We have arranged for all students in Year 9 to visit the Thinktank on Thursday 26 October 2023. The aim of the visit is for students to enrich their learning, and this will also link to their science scheme of learning.

Thinktank is an award-winning science museum which offers ten galleries of historical artefacts, modern interactives, and fantastic futuristic facts. Students will be able to explore everything from aircraft and steam engines to intestines and taste buds - and even emotional robots!

The cost for this visit will be to £9.50 per student and payment should be made via ParentPay. We will travel by coach to The Thinktank, and students are asked to arrive at school for 8.00am with an 8.20am departure from school. We aim to return to school for 3.30pm. As this is outside of normal school hours, please ensure that you have made suitable arrangements for your child to return home safely.

Students will be unsupervised within The Thinktank for parts of the visit; however, staff will be within the general area at all times. Personal accident insurance is covered under the school's educational visits insurance policy.

Students should wear full school uniform and bring a warm, waterproof coat. They will also need to bring writing equipment and a packed lunch, snacks and drinks (no glass bottles please). If they are in receipt of free school meals, a packed lunch can be provided and can be collected on the morning of the visit, if requested.

Whilst on this visit students are reminded that they are representing the school and are expected to behave according to the school's behaviour policy, showing respect and courtesy to the general public. The school reserves the right to refuse any student a place on a visit if his/her behaviour is judged to be inappropriate before the visit. All students will be briefed prior to the visit as to what is expected of them.

The school recommends that the students do not bring any media devices with them on the trip and are reminded that it is their responsibility to look after them at all times and treat those of their fellow students with respect.
