## Dear Parents/Carers

I am writing to inform you about the upcoming Year 7 Baseline Assessments in English, Maths, and Science that are scheduled for all pupils within the CET Trust secondary schools during the week commencing 18 September. We understand that this transition to secondary school can be both exciting and challenging for our Year 7 pupils. Our aim is to provide them with the best possible learning experience, and the baseline assessment is an essential tool in achieving this goal. By understanding each student's starting point, we can develop strategies and interventions to support their progress and ensure their success throughout their time in secondary school.

We will ensure that all students receive clear information about the assessment, including the date, time, and location. Please encourage your child to approach this assessment with a positive mindset and without any undue stress. We are here to support you and your child through this transition and ensure a successful start to their secondary education journey.
