

The Hart School: Pupil Premium 2016-17 Impact Statement.

Progress 8:

Progress 8 is a new measure of the progress pupils make between the end of primary school and the end of secondary school. It's designed to encourage good quality teaching across a broad curriculum. Progress 8 is based on pupils' performance in eight qualifications.

At The Hart School we are very proud of the achievement of all pupils, including Disadvantaged pupils. During 2016/17, there was strong evidence that Disadvantaged pupils performed well compared to their peers.

Key stage 4 Outcomes:

The overall Progress 8 score for Disadvantaged students improved.

- The progress of Disadvantaged pupils in 2016 was below average and has significantly improved to broadly average.
- Disadvantaged students on average achieved a grade C.
- Disadvantaged Middle Prior attainment pupils - was below average in 2016. These pupils have significantly improved to at least above average in 2017.
- Disadvantaged Low Prior attainment pupils - improved in 2017 and is still broadly average.

Y7 & Y8 English and Maths:

- Progress made in Year 7 for 2016/17 was strong in both English and Maths.
- The progress of disadvantaged pupils is improving.
- Three quarters of pupils achieved their end of year aspirational target
- Disadvantaged students exceeded their targets.
- Progress made in Year 8 for 2016/17 was strong in both English and Maths.
- Virtually all students in Year 8 made expected progress and a third of pupils exceeded their aspirational targets.
