Dear Parents and Carers,

Progress Reports and the Pupil Progress App

I am writing to share the outcome of our recent parental survey on student reports, and to explain some key changes that we are making to improve the way in which we report students' progress to parents.

Firstly, thank you to everyone who took the time to complete the survey; we had almost 200 responses. Your feedback is extremely valuable to us, and we are committed to ensuring that, moving forwards, we address and action as many of your requests as possible so that the progress reports we send home provide clear, meaningful, and timely information to support your child's learning.

To support us in being able to provide you with more information about your child's progress, we are pleased to be working with Pupil Progress – an online platform designed to support schools and teachers in tracking and monitoring the progress of students across all subjects and key stages.

The Pupil Progress App

Moving forwards, student reports will be sent to parents using the Pupil Progress app, so it is important to download this tool and arrange your log in details. This app is a simple tool that gives you up-to-date information on your child's progress, making it easier to support them in staying on top of their learning.

The Pupil Progress platform has been helping us track how students are doing, and now the app brings that info directly to you. You'll get quick, detailed updates on how your child is doing in all their subjects.

**Key Benefits of the Pupil Progress App:**

- Real-Time Access to Reports: as soon as a report is published, you will have direct access to detailed progress reports for all subjects, ensuring you are always informed of your child's performance.
- Strengths and Areas for Improvement: The app shows what your child is doing well and where they might need extra help, so we can work together to support them.
- Full Transparency: You'll get a clearer picture of their progress throughout the year, helping you understand their learning journey better.

2) You will receive a separate email with details about how to set up your account once you have downloaded the app. Open that email on your phone and follow the instructions. This email should come through to you before the end of this week.
