We are excited to be creating four new projects thanks to the incredible input from our student voice through cultural capital during tutor time.

The four ideas are designed to enhance learning, foster creativity, and build a stronger school culture. These projects are a direct reflection of our students' ideas and passions, and we look forward to implementing them as a school community.

Introducing Our Four New Student-Lead Projects:

1. **Student Wellbeing Ambassadors** – Students will be trained and supported to promote emotional well-being as well as a positive school environment. They will provide peer support, encourage open conversations about well-being and help create a safe and inclusive space for all students.
2. **Recycling Project** – Students are creating spaces where recycling is more accessible meaning the site will be more efficient in recycling as well as creating a positive eco-friendly environment and culture.
3. **First Aid Training** – Students will join an online workshop which will teach basic first aid and provide advice on how to support in situations such as choking, bleeding and CPR.
4. **Sensory Garden** – A space will be created by the students to provide a safe place for students to enjoy a quiet, nurturing environment.

We are incredibly proud of our students for advocating for these initiatives and demonstrating their commitment to making our school a better place. These projects would not be possible without their voices and your continued support.

Each project will have a capacity and during tutor time this half-term students will be given the chance to sign-up!
