# **Bronze Duke of Edinburgh Recruitment**

I am delighted to announce that we are launching recruitment for the Bronze Duke of Edinburgh's Award (DofE) for students going into Year 9 in September.

## Why do DofE?

Doing DofE is a brilliant way for your young person to discover just how much they are capable of. It gives young people the chance to make new friends, follow their passions, learn new skills and make a difference in our community. Gaining a DofE Award is a great way to impress employers too. It is a non-competitive and a powerful way for every young person to build belief in themselves, whatever their background, interests and abilities.

### How does it work?

To achieve the award, your child will need to complete four sections – Volunteering, Physical, Skills and the Expedition. Students can choose what they would like to do for the first three sections, and we will provide them with guidance and support to help them.

Participants need to spend at least **1 hour a week** on each section (Volunteering, Physical and Skills) for **3 months and 6 months for 1 of the sections** of their choice.

The Expedition involves spending **two days and one night in the countryside**, including camping and hiking. We will make sure that everyone is fully prepared for it with training sessions and a practise expedition weekend.

Dates for the expeditions will be confirmed in September. These will provisionally be the first weekend of the easter holiday 28/29 March 2026 and around May/June 2026.

### How do I sign up?

We hope as many of our students as possible will take this opportunity to get involved with DofE.

The cost is  $\pounds$ 30.50 per person as an enrolment fee onto the scheme. There is also an approximate cost for the expedition section of about £150.

Sign up to join DofE Bronze before Wednesday 17 September via the MS forms link.



Once you have signed up, you will then be invited to make the £30.50 participation fee that goes to the D of E organisation via **Arbor by Friday 3 October.** This will enrol your child onto the course, and you will also receive a bronze welcome pack from the organisation with useful information and advice.

An initial introductory meeting for the participants will take place on Wednesday 8 October, from 3.10 pm until 4 pm in room B09.
