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Dear Parents and Carers,

As exam season begins, here are some key updates to help support your child through the weeks ahead.

### **Booster Sessions**

We have set up a special Booster Timetable for Year 11, giving students extra revision sessions before their exams. These will replace normal lessons and are mostly with their usual teachers. Attendance is compulsory to these sessions and will be monitored, we expect students to engage in these sessions like regular lessons.

#### Exams

Students will be given a personalised exam timetable. We expect them to know in advance where they will be sitting. They also need to bring equipment (2 x black pen, pencil, rubber, ruler, highlighter) in a clear pencil case.

Uniform must be worn as usual, though blazers can be removed in the exam room. **Excessive make up, jewellery, trainers, hoodies and leggings are not allowed**. Students will be sent home to change if needed. Therefore, please ensure your child arrives at school on time in the correct uniform. Let's work together to make sure this doesn't affect the smooth start to their exams.

<u>Students must attend all their scheduled exams.</u> Missed exams may result in families being charged the exam fee.

Morning exams begin at 9.15am, so students must arrive by 8.30am. We strongly recommend arriving earlier to attend our free Breakfast Club from 8.00am, where subject teachers will also be available to support students before their exams.

\*Please also allow extra time for travel due to nearby roadworks to help your child arrive calm and on time.

### Exam Rules & Leaving After Afternoon Exams

The JCQ (exam board regulator) set out strict rules for student behaviour and conduct during exams. Students have been informed of these expectations, we would appreciate you reminding them too. Full details can be found <u>here</u>.

Some afternoon exams finish after 2.30pm. On those days, students can go home early with <u>your permission</u>. Please complete this <u>MS Form</u> to give consent. Without it, your child will stay in school for supervised revision.
