

Year 11 Student Contract



As a student in Year 11 at The Hart School, I understand that to be successful, I must:

- Be in school on time every day
- Attend all lessons, including period zero, on time and with the correct equipment
- Work to the best of my ability in lessons
- Complete all homework on time and to the best of my ability
- Attend all the interventions that I am invited to
- Complete all vocational submissions to the best of my ability and on time
- Attend any additional interventions and masterclasses
- Set up a revision timetable and revise to the best of my ability for all my exams including pre-public examinations
- Sit all PPEs in the correct room

As a school, we will reward students who do all of the above in the following ways:

- Invite students to the End of Year 11 Prom
- Invite students to the last day celebration and leavers' assembly
- Reward students for their efforts and achievements

I understand that, if my Hart Points are in negative equity by Friday 7th May 2027, I will not be invited to the school prom or the last day celebration. The monitoring period will be Thursday 3rd September 2026 to Friday 7th May 2027.

I also understand that, even after the monitoring period and receiving an invitation to the prom, this invitation could be revoked, depending on my behaviour.

Examples reasons as to why I may be in negative equity:

- Receive multiple classroom removals
- Receive multiple internal exclusions
- Receive a suspension from school
- Be regularly late to school / lessons / period zero / assembly

I also understand that if any of the criteria below applies, I will not be invited to the school prom or the last day celebration:

- Refusal to sit any PPEs
- Refusal to complete vocational submissions
- Less than 92% attendance (without medical evidence)
- Anything to put the school's reputation at risk through poor behaviour on the way to or from school / outside of school
- Any significant breach of the behaviour policy
