Ski Trip 2024 – Dry Slope Ski Lessons

We are currently in the process of arranging the ski lessons for those students who will be skiing with us in Artesina in February 2024.

The sessions will take place at Swadlincote Ski Centre on a **Thursday** evening, directly after school finishes. The cost of the lessons was incorporated in the payments you are making for the ski trip. The lessons will take place on the following dates: 5 October, 12 October; 19 October; 26 October.

Students will leave the school site at 3.15 pm and we aim to be back at the school for 6.45 pm, traffic dependent. Please ensure that you collect your child from school or make alternative arrangements for them to return home safely.

We suggest that your child brings a snack that they can eat on the way to or from the ski centre, as it's a long day. They will need to wear warm clothing, possibly a waterproof coat, weather depending. Please don't worry, this doesn't need to be full ski gear, we are aware that Christmas happens between now and then! However, wearing ski socks will enable them to get a feel for how the boots should fit.

Please note that for safety reasons, they will be unable to go on the slope without gloves and full arm and leg cover.
