This guide has been put together to ensure your child is able to adhere to our uniform policy and provides a visual aid.

Shoes

Images of acceptable shoes:





Plain, Black, Leather and Polishable

Rubber soles are not permitted

Suede shoes are not permitted

Boot (including ankle boots) are not permitted

Images of acceptable trousers:





Tailored, straight leg fit, formal style and must cover ankle

Images of unacceptable trousers:



Trousers that are *not* **acceptable**: corduroy, linen, skinny trousers, denim, leggings, jeggings, cropped, tightly or highly fitted, chinos, casual styles or trousers with 'buckle' belts/zips or any other form of decoration.

Images of adaptations to uniform that are not permitted.



- 1. Hairclips are not permitted to be worn as an accessory to the blazer
- 2. Blazer sleeves are not permitted to be rolled up
- 3. Fake tan must not be worn
- 4. False nails are not permitted
- 5. Trousers must not be rolled up
- 6. Silver buckles must be removed from shoes
- 7. Additional jewellery such as bracelets are not permitted
- 8. Sunglasses must not be worn in the school building
- 9. Anklets are not permitted
