In addition to the support available through the school, parents and carers may find the following community initiatives helpful:

- **“Staffordshire School Uniforms – Free... Strictly No Selling”** – a community Facebook group where families can request or donate pre-loved school uniform free of charge. While The Hart School does not actively promote or endorse social media platforms, we are aware that many families have found this group to be a useful source of support.
- **Pre-Loved Uniform Market** – organised by the Salvation Army Church in partnership with Staffordshire Libraries, providing families with access to affordable or free school uniform.
- Various **local church uniform events** are held throughout the academic year across Staffordshire. Information about these events is regularly shared by Staffordshire County Council.

From September 2026, whenever information about local pre-loved uniform events is received by the school, we will share it with parents and carers through our usual communication channels to help families access the support available.
