EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Our extra-curricular provision provides an extensive range of opportunities for all students to broaden their experiences, develop creative skills and take their interests further.



As well as ensuring academic success, we are serious about having fun and enjoying time at school. This is achieved through providing a wealth of extra curricular activities for students for engage in.

All of our students are gifted in different ways, we aim to unlock those gifts and help our students to flourish. Helping our students to develop in the areas that they love is a central part of education at The Hart School. Whether your child is an avid sportsperson, a budding musician, at home on the stage, or all of the above, then there are endless opportunities to grow these skills. Whether they love to dance, paint, draw or debate, they will be supported to develop.

All after school activities take place from 15:15pm to 16:15pm. Different clubs are offered each term so there is always the chance for our students to try out something new. We offer around 50 clubs and activities each term, encompassing a vast range of interests and hobbies. Staff are encouraged to share their own interests with students through after school activities and we encourage our students to try new things every term. After-School activities are as much part of the curriculum for us as English and Maths. We believe it is these new and challenging experiences which help our students grow and develop, as well as unlock hidden talents. This link between curricular and extra-curricular activities forms a key part of developing the whole child, and building the confidence of our pupils by showcasing and giving equal weighting to their strengths in every area of the school day.

The Sport and Performing Arts faculties offer lunchtime and after school clubs in a wide range of areas: athletics, cheer squad, cross country, dance, fitness and games including badminton, cricket, football, hockey, netball, and tennis. Students take part in matches and tournaments against other schools locally and regionally. They are also encouraged to take part in City and County teams and beyond. We support students who perform at national level in their chosen sports, working closely with parents to help balance their school work and training commitments.

Alongside this there is a varied programme of other activities including: Dungeons and Dragons Club, Book Club, Japanese Club, Duke of Edinburgh and Young Enterprise.




