Inspiring Academic Excellence




Students' growth in these areas is developed across all aspects of their school experience: subject lessons, tutor time, assemblies and wider curricular opportunities.

Recognising the importance of developing well-rounded individuals, we offer an exciting programme of co-curricular activities.



The Hart School Leadership Programme aims to increase the opportunities for students across the school.


